Meadow Lake Condo Dues Increase:

An announcement was made at the November annual meeting that the Monthly Association Fees for Meadow Lake were being increased.

The New Fees are as follows:

A unit \$160.00
B unit \$147.00
C unit \$144.00
D unit \$131.00



This is a 5% increase from the dues charged in 2006. Our consistent up keeping of our Maintenance and Landscaping issues are the reason for this increase. By far, the most complaints we get are for Landscaping issues, and we are committed to keeping the Grounds and Maintenance up, so we will not have to deal with issues of neglect. This increase was announced at our annual meeting, as well as mailed to all co-owners in December. Please mark your calendars, and remember that the change in fees go into effect on January 1, 2007.

The Meadow Lake Board of Directors thanks all co-owners who showed up at our annual meeting. We appreciate the suggestions and feedback, given at that meeting, and we are committed to make the necessary improvements to our complex. One such item that was brought up by a co-owner, was that her window lock latches are broken. It is the responsibility of the Meadow Lake Association to maintain and repair the windows through out the complex. We are looking into vendors to get these latches fixed, however we will need your help. If you have window latches that do not lock, please drop the association a note, so we can have a good idea of how many would need to be repaired. Once we have that information, then we can proceed, in finding a vendor to fix them. At the meeting, there

were two co-owners who had broken latches; however, not every co-owner attended the meeting. If you are a co-owner who has latches that do not lock, drop us a note, or mail it in with your association dues.

LIVING IN A WINTER WONDER LAND

We have not gone through the first really large storm of the winter yet, however, the snow removal protocol needs to be readdressed, since we have new co-owners who were not living here last year.

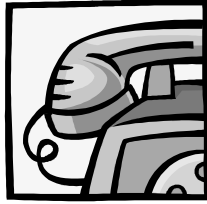
1. Our snow removal crew comes early to plow the street first.
2. Once this is done, the parking lots are plowed. If you park in the parking lot, then it is advised that your vehicle be moved to the street, as soon as the street has been plowed.
3. After the parking lot, sidewalks and porches are cleared.
4. This process may be repeated, should we have a really heavy snowstorm.

Our landscape service will work diligently to remove snow and ice from our streets, driveways, sidewalks and porches. But wind and shade can defeat even the best efforts, and you may need de-icer from time to time to make the area around your home safe. It is the feeling of the board that rock salt can damage our expensive cement work, so de-icer is purchased and distributed each winter to those who desire it.

If you would like De-icer this winter and have a Milk jug type container, you may place this on Terry Entwistle's porch. (24619) If you put your house number on the container, Terry can have it filled with de-icer for your sidewalks and other needful areas, and will deliver it to your porch in a timely manner. If you do not have a container, please fill out the form printed elsewhere in this letter, and deliver the form to Terry's front door in a plastic bag and hang it from the knob.
