DRYER VENTS

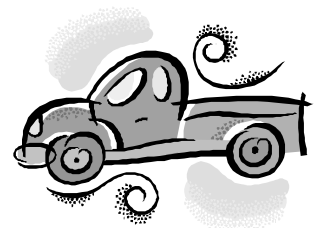
If interested in hiring the maintenance person who cleans out the dryer vents for one of our neighboring complexes, call Kurt of Dalton Environmental 1-800-675-2298. He comes well recommended and will clean the vent that goes from your dryer to the outside. Clogged dryer vents raise your utility bill because it takes longer for clothes to dry if the vent is clogged, but more importantly lint in a clogged vent can catch fire that can cause damage or even destroy your home. In addition, in the winter if the flap on the outside does not close completely cold air can come into your home, raising your heating bill.

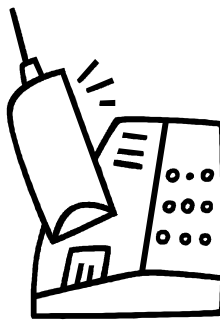
