## LIVING IN A WINTER WONDER LAND

We have not gone through the first really large storm of the winter yet. It is a good time to mention the snow removal protocol for new residents.

1. Our snow removal crew comes early to plow the street first.
2. Once this is done, the parking lots are plowed. If you park in the parking lot, it is advised you move your vehicle to the street, as soon as the street has been plowed.
3. After the parking lot, sidewalks and porches are cleared.
4. This process may be repeated, should we have a really heavy snowstorm.

Our landscape service will work diligently to remove snow and ice from our streets, driveways, sidewalks and porches. But wind and shade can defeat even the best efforts, and you may need deicer from time to time to make the area around your home safe. It is the felt that rock salt can damage our expensive cement work, so deicer is purchased and distributed each winter to those who desire it. Terry Entwistle, Vice President in charge of grounds will again distribute deicer to residents this year.



### **If you need deicer:**

- Fill out the tag form printed elsewhere in this letter, and deliver the form to Terry's front door (24619) in a plastic bag and hang it from the knob. Terry will have a container delivered to your porch for your use.
- If you run out, leave the empty container with your house number on it on Terry's porch or leave another note in a bag on his door, and he will make the delivery.

## HOLIDAY DECORATIONS




