## SHRUB TRIMMING

Keep children and pets inside until the application has completely dried, usually that takes about an hour. Also please remove any objects from your railings.

## KEEPING THINGS COOL

Your air conditioner condenser will work much better if you keep it free of dust, dirt and debris. This can be taken care of very easily with your garden hose nozzle or with a brush or broom. A lot of the heating and cooling people recommend to us that the hose is usually the most effective method. Also, keep changing your furnace filter, even in the summer. This will also help with the functioning and good operation of your condenser

## FISH FLIES

It looks like fish flies are making an early appearance this year. You may turn off your outside flood light during the season if you wish because the flies do make a mess and are very attracted to the light when it is on. Just be sure you turn it back on when the season is over (usually only 2-3 weeks). Also, try to sweep up the mess they leave every few days or so to keep the mess at a minimum. Thanks for your cooperation.
